Language Requirement A modification of the foreigh language requirement in the College of Arts and Sciences has been proposed to the Academic Council and is awaiting approval for implementation in

September, 1973. The existing requirement has called for three semesters in a foreign language, classical or modern, with appropriate reductions for those students who have received advanced standing on the basis of high school achievement. The proposed modification would allow the substitution of a semester in linguistics and/or a semester in foreign literature in translation in partial fulfillment of the requirement. The change, if approved, will probably increase enrollments in courses in Greek and Latin literature in translation. At the same time it will not permit students to graduate from the College without some experience in a foreign language.

Professor John B. McDiarmid has announced his intention to give up the chairmanship of the department at the end of the current academic year. He is planning to take a sabbatical leave for the 1973-74 term and will then return to active teaching.

On April 3, Professor William Biers of the University of Missouri, will present a lecture for the Seattle Society of the AIA on "Recent Excavations at Phlius, Greece 1972."

The department is again offering a full program during the summer session. New this year is a course in English on Greek and Roman Religion and Cult, offered by Professor Harmon. Professor Edmonson will again offer an intensive course in Modern Greek; there also will be an intensive course in Elementary Latin. There will be no course in Latin teaching methods and materials but Professor Read will be available for consultation.
